

Warham Parish Council – Clerk’s Report – 17 March 2022

It looks as if the recreational area problem has finally been solved – Flagship have agreed to fence off the prospective children’s playground from the rest of the area. I have therefore signed the “Memorandum of Understanding” on behalf of the Parish Council, and in theory there is no reason why the building cannot commence. We shall have to wait and see whether any other problems are invented to slow the process down.

We will have to think about how best to provide a children’s play area for the above, although I would imagine that we will be starting small and adding to it over the years.

Now that a small amount of interest is payable again on deposit accounts. I have transferred £3000 from the current account to the deposit account. This will form the basis for the future playground.

With regard to item 6) I have received appeals from the following:

Priscilla Bacon Hospice – appeal for funds towards £12.5m cost of new hospice at the N&N

Norfolk Citizens Advice Bureau – general funding

Burnham Market Area Community Car Scheme – funds towards cost of supplying car service to patients in the Burnham Market and Wells Areas, also delivering medicines etc., during lockdowns.

No appeal received but Heritage House Wells continues to deliver hot meals to local housebound people.
