July and August have been relatively quiet due to lack of policy coming out of Westminster.

NNDC did enter two bids for the Levelling up Fund, one for a swimming pool and 3g pitch for Fakenham and the second for remedial works along the Cliff paths and North Lodge Park in Cromer. As before the timescale for entering the bids was unreasonable and Officers at NNDC worked very hard to get them completed on time only to find that the Government Gateway couldn't accept the bids causing a two-week delay. Both bids were approved by our MPs, Jerome Mayhew for the Fakenham bid and Duncan Baker for the Cromer bid. We should hear by 6th October.

Nutrient Neutrality continues to affect planning applications. It has been rumoured that Nutrient Neutrality will be revoked under the new administration, but we are waiting for this to be confirmed.

Obviously, the biggest concern is for residents struggling with bills and businesses trying to cope with the massive increases in fuel charges. Again, we await the plans being drawn up by Government.

I will keep the pressure on re Affordable Housing Development.
